Keeping you as parents/carers involved in your child's learning is very important to us and in advance of September we would like to share some important information:

#### Reading

- 1 Independent reading book, to be recorded by child in their Reading Record. Children will be given an opportunity throughout the school week to change their book but please keep reminding you child to change it when they have finished too.
- 1 library book
- Guided reading will take place each week, and a Guided Reading slip will be stuck into the reading record to record what your child has been focusing on that week.

#### Home Learning

- The purpose of Home Learning is to consolidate and extend prior learning
- Children should be able to complete tasks independently.
- Home Learning is set on a Wednesday and handed in by the following Monday
- Concerns regarding Home Learning should be shared with the Class Teacher

#### Home School Communication

- Your child's Class Teacher should always be your first point of contact
- Year 3 Team are available on the Lower Key Stage 2 door every morning/home time
- Reading Records sent home/brought back into school everyday
- Feedback can be shared with PTA/Parent Council Reps and Parent Governors

#### Collection Arrangements

- The children will be walked from the Lower Key Stage 2 door to the edge of the playground. When they can see the adult collecting them they will be able to join you.
